This property, situated in heart of the picturesque village of Fuissé, is one of the few large estates in the area, covering 17 hectares. It has been owned by 6 generations of the Dutron family since 1835 but the estate has been growing grapes since the 13th century. The vineyards are situated in the villages of Fuissé and Solutre. The estate is known for its old vines, some of which are over 65 years old. Maxime Dutron uses traditional methods in the vineyards and in his temperature-controlled cellar. His wines are regular medal winners in the many French competitions.
